OUR CEO

Dear stakeholders, members, and advocates of Silver Key Senior Services,

Please accept this invitation to review the milestones and related updates from Silver Key Senior Services for the year 2023–2024. This report reflects our enduring commitment to supporting older adults with compassion, dignity, and forward-thinking solutions.

This year has brought extraordinary momentum. One of our most significant accomplishments was the groundbreaking and ongoing construction of a 50-unit affordable senior apartment complex, including 13 units specifically reserved for veterans. This major development represents a milestone in our mission to address the critical need for safe, affordable housing for older adults in the Pikes Peak region. The progress made so far would not be possible without the collaborative support of generous funders, community partners, and advocates like you.

We are proud of our progress and humbled by the continued support of individuals like you—our advocates, donors, and friends.

Silver Key emphasized the growing need for additional funding and volunteers to sustain and expand our Meals on Wheels program. As demand increases, so does the



Importance of ensuring that older adults receive not only nutritious meals but also regular wellness checks and muchneeded social connection.

In early 2023, with the support of a multiyear grant from the NextFifty Initiative, Silver Key launched the Colorado Springs Aging Project (CSAP). This initiative is focused on documenting and testing the power of hope to improve the lives of older adults—furthering our mission to enhance quality of life through measurable, evidence-based practices.

We were also proud to host our Senior Sunrise event on May 10, 2024. This special occasion featured inspirational guest speakers, the presentation of the 2024 Champion Award, and meaningful fundraising to support essential programs and services for older adults.

Internally, we have begun foundational work on the development of a new website. This project focuses on clear,

streamlined messaging and improved senior-friendly functionality. In collaboration with Design Rangers, we are laying the groundwork for an online experience that is more intuitive, inclusive, and reflective of our mission.

We have also made strides in donor engagement, validating a third of our donor records, and achieved measurable cost savings through strategic IT resource management—ensuring more of our resources go directly to supporting seniors in need.

This year, we proudly hosted the largest senior expo in El Paso County at the Great Wolf Lodge. This free event featured over 80 senior service exhibitors, health screenings, engaging senior activities, and presentations from special guest speakers. It was a day of community, connection, and empowerment for older adults and those who support them.

Throughout the year, our volunteers and staff have exemplified dedication and heart. Through new staff training programs and thousands of hours of volunteer service, our team continues to elevate the quality and reach of care we provide.

We are proud of our progress and humbled by the continued support of individuals like you—our advocates, donors, and friends. Together, we are shaping a Pikes Peak region where seniors age with dignity, connection, and hope.

MILESTONES & ACHIEVEMENTS

SENIOR SUNRISE EVENT

On May 10, 2024, Silver Key hosted the annual Senior Sunrise event, featuring engaging guest speakers, the presentation of the 2024 Champion Award, and fundraising efforts to support critical services for older adults in the region.

LAUNCH OF THE COMPREHENSIVE SENIOR ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CSAP)

With the support of a multi-year grant from the NextFifty Initiative, Silver Key launched CSAP in early 2023. This program aims to measure and promote the role of hope in improving the lives of older adults through research and community engagement.

SILVER KEY SENIOR SUMMIT & EXPO

Silver Key hosted the largest senior expo in El Paso County at the Great Wolf Lodge, offering over 80 senior service exhibitors, health screenings, engaging presentations, senior-focused activities, and a pop-up thrift store—fostering education, connection, and empowerment for older adults.

MEALS ON WHEELS PROGRAM ADVOCACY

Recognizing growing demand, Silver Key highlighted the urgent need for increased funding and volunteer support for its Meals on Wheels program to continue providing nutritious meals and vital social contact to isolated seniors.

TRI-LAKES SENIOR CENTER RELOCATION

Silver Key successfully transitioned the Tri-Lakes Senior Center from its previous site at Grace Best in Monument to a new, improved location—expanding services and accessibility for seniors in northern El Paso County.




