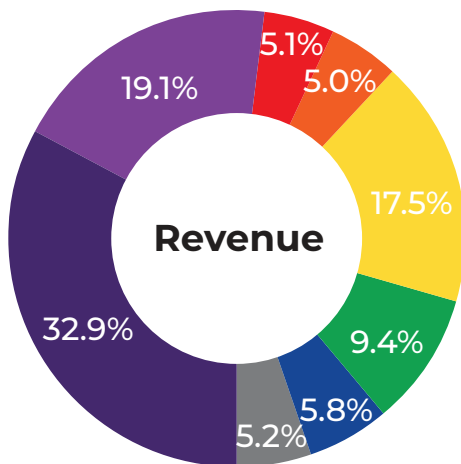

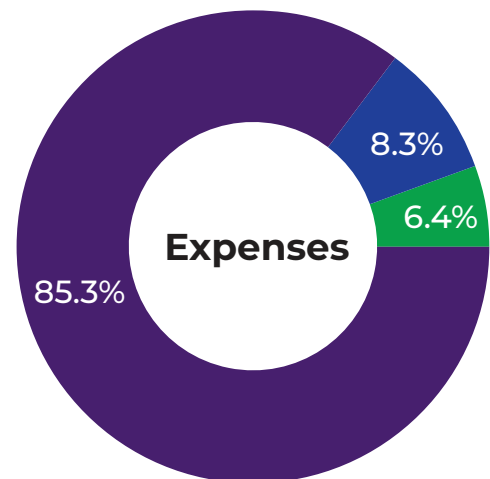
## FISCAL YEAR MILESTONES 2018-19
