This service provides nutritious meals in a social setting to eligible diners and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex or religion. All meals are prepared to meet $\frac{1}{3}$ of the recommended dietary allowance (RDA) for seniors. The service also provides Nutrition Education.

Our Mission:

- Increase independence and enhance quality of life

Funding and how the program works:

Silver Key Connections Café receives funding from federal and state grants, the City of Colorado Springs, City of Manitou Springs, Title III of the Older Americans Act and from generous donations. The Pikes Peak Area Agency on Aging, local churches, and charitable individuals in the community also contribute valuable resources to the program.

Who is eligible?

- Anyone 60 years of age or older
- The spouse of an eligible diner
- Disabled persons under 60 years of age who reside in housing facilities occupied primarily by older adults and at which Silver Key Connections Café services are provided

How much do meals cost?

The suggested donation for an eligible diner is \$3.50, but no eligible person is denied a meal because of inability to give.

Donations are used to offset the cost of meals and expand the program to more seniors. If a friend or family member less than 60 years of age would like to join an eligible diner for lunch, they are welcome to do so. The guest fee for a non-eligible diner is \$7.50.
