#### **APARTMENTS UPDATE**

e are pleased to share some exciting updates about Silver Key's affordable housing project.

If you haven't already heard the Silver Key Apartments will be a 50-unit affordable housing development for individuals aged 62 and older, with 13 units specifically designated for veterans. It is conveniently located adjacent to the Silver Key headquarters on S. Murray, where residents will have easy access to all our services, including the food pantry and thrift store.
